Purple Plunge History

When the Bordenave and Hunt families lost two family matriarchs in 2003 and 2013 respectively, they were inspired to join the fight against this disease. They began to raise money for the American Cancer Society by participating in the Relay for Life Walk. In order to increase donations for the Walk, Paul Hunt organized the "Purple Plunge." On March 15th, 2014, the family along with a group of volunteers and key members of the community, worked together to make the 1st Annual Purple Plunge a reality. On that day, 50 brave souls took the Plunge and raised over \$11,000.

In 2016, we received our official 501(c)(3) nonprofit status. This enables us to direct all monies raised to those residents of our communities who are battling cancer. Paul continues to lead this effort with boundless energy and positivity.

Since that first Plunge our numbers have continued to grow. In 2024, we had 649 plungers, 48 Teams, and 29 sponsors, and raised over \$273,000.
